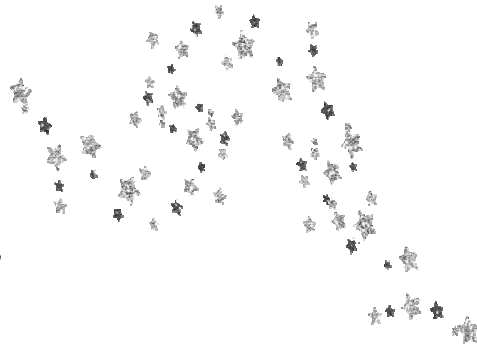
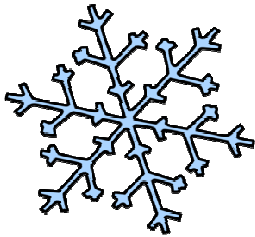

Labels for Education - Clip the labels for education with the UPC off of participating products or bring in beverage/sauce caps.

Turn the labels into your child's teacher. You can visit Labelsforeducation.com for more resources. Our school is able to purchase items for the school or classrooms through their point system.



Apparel Order Deadline: January 8th

All Apparel orders must be placed on an Apparel Order Form available in the office or online. We do not stock Apparel; however we may have a few items available, you can check availability with Mrs. Newell. All apparel orders are processed through the office and are filled in the order they are received. Orders will take a minimum of 3 weeks or more to process after the order is placed. No refunds. Call the office to set up an appointment to check sizing.



Payments

When making your checks out to the school or day care, please be sure to put your child's name on the check.

Payments are due by the 10th of each month, August through May.

The Payment Drop Box is located in the front office for your convenience. All Cash payments require a receipt. Please do not place cash in the drop box.

We accept American Express, Discover, MasterCard, & Visa Credit Card payments for Tuition Only. There is a \$5.00 transaction fee per transaction.
